  - **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE REVIEWED FOR CONSIDERATION IN THE CLASS**
3. You must attend ***ALL*** sessions.
  - Those failing to attend ***ALL*** sessions may be asked to withdraw or may not graduate.
